FULL MOON

Full Moons put the lights on what is currently going on in our lives and the events that have occurred since the last New Moon, which took place on March 26. These are times of revelation. What have been revealed in your life over the last two weeks, two months? It is of great importance that we take the time to take stock of our lives every day, as the changes seem to be taking place at warp speed. This is not a focus on what is wrong with our life, but what is changing, how are we responding and where will the current changes lead?

This Libra Full Moon takes place on April 9th at 20 degrees of Aries/Libra. Aries is the first sign of the horoscope and therefore is about new beginnings. Are you willing to change your mind, try something new, reach and stretch in your life? So many people are discovering that what has *always* worked may have become obsolete or ineffective in the shifting paradigms of the new Age. The Moon in Libra puts attention on our interconnection with others. We are required to consider the desires of others, as well as our own.

Pluto is beginning its yearly retrograde on April 4th which will strongly influence this Full Moon plus the next three lunations. Pluto calls us to move into the future by letting go of the past, rather than referring to the past.

The ongoing influence of the Saturn/Uranus opposition is affecting everyone for the next fifteen months. For those who have planets that are aspecting by this opposition the affect is even stronger. When inner planets—in this case Mars—link with outer planets—the Saturn/Uranus opposition—the winds of change blow with greater force. On April 4th Mars opposes Saturn and cojoins Uranus in Pisces on the 15th of April. This means that is the cliché think outside the box suddenly means let go of the fact that there ever was a box. Saturn is efficient and practical; Uranus is bold and inventive. Mars adds energy to both aspects and can build a fire under the sluggish or put life on a rocket ship to the Moon. Saturn can be staid and Uranus is always erratic.

Venus is still retrograde as the month begins and has two squares to Pluto coming up—one April 17th and one May 2th. Over the past year the economic events every where in the world have brought us up against the headlong spending spree that the world has been following. Venus represents our desires. Pluto is revelation. As things are settling down a bit, people are beginning to find renewed joy in being more involved with each other. Being pushed to be more creative, more connected and more involved is awakening a sense of personal power that has not been experienced in a long time. The initial shock of a failing money market brought pain and fear. Now we are beginning to appreciate returning to a more simplistic life and the rewards that self-sufficiency brings.

At this Full Moon the Sun at 20 degrees Aries will call you to take a risk or step into the unknown, while the Moon at 20 degrees Libra can cause you to reach out to friends and/or family in a moment when you feel alone or unsupported.

On April 11th Jupiter crosses the 21st degree which is where the February eclipse occurred. When a planet reactivates the point of an eclipse it is like the snooze alarm going off. If you ignored the first wake-up call this is the second one. The wake-up calls don't go away, they get more intense with each alarm. We cannot sleep through what is going on, on Earth now. This Full Moon cojoins the Dwarf star Eris, the Goddess of Strife, awakening many to another adventure into their own mythology. Venus shows us what we desire and Eris pushes us to "go for it!"

The Sabian Symbols are: Sun in Aries: "A young girl feeding birds in winter; overcoming crises through compassion". Moon in Libra: A rabbi performing his duties; the ability to draw on the power of an ancestral tradition in order to serve and inspire one's

fellowmen." These symbols focus on caring and supporting each other.

We are reminded that "Prosperity is a way of living and thinking, and not just money or things. Poverty is a way of living and thinking, and not just money or things." (Eric Butterworth)

Planetary aspects are from *The Mountain Astrologer* and the Sabian symbols are from *The Astrology of Personality* by Dane Rudhyar.

NEW MOON

The new Moon in Taurus falls on the 24-25th of April. As Mars is the warrior and focuses on anger, strategy and conflict, Venus and Taurus put the emphasis on beauty, harmony and the arts. The loveliness of life is like a healing balm. It soothes our soul and heals our heart. The word April comes from the Latin word *operio*, which means "I open". April opens us to spring, movement and allowing of new life. Taurus, which is ruled by the Goddess or Empress in the Tarot deck, is about fertility, abundance and plenty. We are called to get into life and embrace it.

Just before this New Moon occurs, Venus, ruler of Taurus and Libra, returns to Aries. The message of the Full and New Moon of March was "get out of your rut". Mars and Venus will cojoin at 29 degrees of Pisces on April 21st. This meeting in the last degree of the last sign speaks of old doors closing and movement to a whole new level of awareness opening us to vision. Mars and Venus will dance together within ten degrees of each other until mid-July. This closeness of God/Goddess/All that Is in the Heavens inspires us to consider our own inner male and female. What is the relationship of your masculine and feminine aspects? Is one still in domination over the other? Are you willing to allow a balance of masculine and feminine nature in your life without making one gender more powerful or important than the other? Everything on Earth is changing, including male dominance and Patriarchal rule. Venus is bringing the Goddess another giant step forward in her emergence into equality. Venus is moving toward its third square with Pluto which will be exact on May 2. Mars will make an exact square to Pluto on April 26. Humanity is being led to really look at everything that is and has been going on, on the planet and make huge changes. The disregard of Mother Earth and all of Nature requires a totally new attitude. A new reality is being birthed that will bring about deep, fundamental changes in the collective consciousness.

The three S's—simplicity, sincerity and sustainability-are an essence to live by and with.

Mercury in Taurus is moving toward a square with Jupiter/Neptune in Aquarius. This opens the psyche to greater vision and puts stability under the dreams of a new day. Almost as the captain leans into the wheel to turn the course of his ship, we each are being called to change the course of our own personal destiny. This square will bring about better collaboration, greater innovation and increased optimism. The wheel of destiny is turning away from so much focus on personal gain and more thought about a greater good that brings a better life to all.

The Uranus/Pluto conjunctions in Virgo in the 60's planted important seeds of this new reality. Saturn now moving through Virgo is restimulating those degrees and strengthening the call to action rather than battle. The Sabian symbol for this New Moon at 6 degrees of Taurus is: "Cantilever bridge across a deep gorge; the conquest of separativeness through group-cooperation." Often we have said, "God deliver us from a committee". This New Moon shows us a better way of discovering creative solutions through collective efforts. Our motto can become, "Together we can cross any divide, meet any challenge, solve any problem." "Yes, we can!"

TAROT TALK



THE EMPEROR

The Tarot card for the month of April is the Emperor. The Emperor builds the material world, hence the relationship with the number four, number of the Emperor's card. The four corners of any foundation, four legs under a table, the four directions, four seasons and four elements (earth, wind, fire and air)—all of these indicate strength and stability. One of the words that we are hearing more and more today is sustainability. The number four associates with sustainability.

Like the Emperor reach for the top. Strive for the best. Allow your creations to make this world a better place for all, by building a world that is open and acceptant to everyone. Using the elements of the four aspects of the minor arcane you can make your own world more beautiful. The four of Wands calls for Aspiration. Set your goals high. Remember to keep yourself grounded in clear and practical understanding with the *Logic* of the four of Crystals (mind). Act on your goals and plans. The Emperor, like the sign of Aries, is a real go-getter. The four of Worlds indicates new beginnings—Commencement. It can be the harbinger of a new creation or project.
