ASTROLOGY

FULL MOON

This Full Moon in Gemini is the last of the SuperMoons of 2008. The Super Moon occurs when the Moon is both at perigee (its closest approach to Earth and syzygy (directly aligned with the Sun and Earth). Gravitational pulls are much more intense around a SuperMoon and this impacts our psyches as well. This Full Moon creates a Grand Square with Saturn, principle of physical reality, in Virgo and Uranus, the portal of metaphysical reality, in Pisces. A Grand Cross or Square always means that we are standing at a crossroads in our lives and we must choose to align our actions with our beliefs or "square" off with those beliefs.

The further a planet orbits from the Sun, the more encompassing its perspective and the more we are challenged to include that archetype in our awareness and identity. The ongoing oppositions of Saturn to Uranus offers a way up and out of the situations that we find ourselves involved in at this time. Uranus is the archetype of chaos and creation, symbolizing the conception of new forms, new paradigms and new realities. In the sign of Pisces this brings the awakening of souls that have been asleep for centuries. This spiritual revolution is not another holy war, but a requirement of us to wake up to who we truly are and our purpose for being here. These planets will actually be leading the way and offering a guiding light until July 2010 when they make their last opposition to one another.

Mars, the mythic God of War, is conjunct the Sun at this lunation, adding its energy to the Grand Cross. This spurs us on to greater things by igniting our courage and calling us to act on our convictions.

The Sabian Symbols for this Full Moon underscore the importance of community and cooperation. For the Moon at 22 degrees Gemini: "Dancing couples in a harvest festival; the wholesome enjoyment of organic processes and emotional drives." For the sun at 22 degrees of Sagittarius: "A Chinese laundry; making use of one's special racial-cultural background in order to survive and prosper in an alien environment." This is a time of Big, Big changes. Everyone is required to climb out of the rut and make a new way. Change is always for the better, though sometimes it doesn't seem that way in the moment.

NEW MOON

Conjunctions always indicate the end of a cycle and the gateway to the next adventure. This New Moon in Capricorn is concerned with the responsible management of our resources and collective structures. The question of how to equitably divide up and use the Earth—land, water, oil, mineral and property rights, government, corporations and institutions of all kinds—is of greatest importance to all.. All of these areas are up for major change because we have allowed the planet to be used in an inequitable way for far too long. Capricorn urges us to face and master the challenges of the physical world. Spirit is infinite; matter is not. We have long been a boundriless society.

We must learn how to respect the boundaries of our own lives and those of others. We are being forced to be responsible in the truest sense of the word—for ourselves. The parental order has encouraged everyone to mind the business of others while their own affairs became more and more tangled. We all can see how someone else could "do it better". Now we must adjust our sights to improve our own way. We must take dominion over our own lives, be our own authority by developing maturity, integrity and self-sufficiency. "They" are not responsible for us—we are. Even those who are sick, physically handicapped or young can hold an intention for the very best outcome of their life rather than resorting to helplessness or victimization. The more we take charge of our own lives the easier things will be for everyone. This is a beginning, not an end. We are not "sheeple", we are God's people.

Two very interesting points occur at this New Moon at put an emphasis on the Divine male and female. Mars, male energy, is conjunct its higher spiritual octave of Pluto and Venus, feminine energy, is conjunct its higher spiritual octave of Neptune. This calls forth the highest and best of both man and woman on the planet.

Mars represents personal will and Pluto is divine collective will. This exact conjunction the day after the New Moon stresses the necessity for major economic and social transformation—away from the primary goal of personal financial gain (I feel that the attitude of fear of not enough is what really has to be attended to) and toward the highest good of all concerned. Pluto is associated with power and wealth. This includes the power of fear, the power of the shadow and the wealth that is gained when we delve into our unconscious mind. Capricorn deals with law and order. For a long time the law has played for its own side. Even in the metaphysics of our basic legal foundations the judges sit for the bank and not for the people. It has been "We are not going to play this game according to Hoyle! We are going to play the game according to how things will prosper the least amount of people." Everyone has known it, many have fought it, but nothing will change until the collective consciousness shifts to a place where the common belief in victimization is forgiven. Pluto's transit through Capricorn reflects a breakdown in plutocracy (where the real power is wielded by the wealthy) and an establishment of a new social order that is heartcentered rather than power-centered. Pluto descends into unrevealed and brings it to light. Arthur descended into hell to bring back the caldron of power of the Goddess. The Goddess is emerging to bring the love, the compassion and the heart-felt truth that can change the direction of the world at this time. Pluto is revealing the shadow side of the masculine: domination and destruction. The spiritual male stands for protection and preservation in the sense of liberation rather than control. Although Pluto and

Mars cojoin every two years this particular blending is more powerful because of Pluto's recent enter into Capricorn. This brings about a collective initiation into the sacred masculine, which emerges when we have faced and integrated the shadow side. Somewhere in the fifties everyone meets their shadow, according to Lazaris. When we meet the shadow we can attempt to return to our youth, give up and wait for death or face it and enter into a state of wisdom and immortality that comes from facing death and overcoming it.

On December 27th, Venus conjuncts Neptune at 22 degrees Aquarius. Neptune highlights the sacred feminine principle. It stands for unconditional love, while Venus is personal affection. The co-joining of Neptune and Venus at the New Moon brings an initiation of the heart, opening the awareness of our interconnectedness and interdependence. We have been taught that love is a weakness and something both desired and feared. We must now move into a higher perspective of what love is and how it operates in everyone's life.

From Thanksgiving to New Year's Eve there are no retrograde planets, for the first time in 2008. This is a cosmic message to make as much forward movement as possible. On January 1, Saturn stations to go retrograde which will slow now the movement that began on November 27 when Uranus went direct. While Saturn is retrograde we will be able to see more clearly what is no longer working in our lives. We can forgive, release, transmute or integrate the energy into our lives in a new way.

The Sabian symbol for this New Moon at 7 degrees Capricorn calls us to attend to the messages of our higher self.: "A veiled prophet speaks, seized by the power of a god; the ability to act as a mouthpiece for the revelation of a transcendent will and truth determining future action." This is a time of contemplation on what we must release and what we truly desire to bring into our lives. Remember that what you think upon will be your tomorrow.

CRYSTAL CORNER

The holidays are upon us and soon a new year. If you're like me, you are seeking ways to let go of some old things that no longer serve and allow others to manifest for our ongoing. A number of stones might be useful but I have decided on two primary ones for now.



ASTROPHYLLITE is a stone of light to dark matrix with patterns of gold fibers within. It has a most interesting energy. As there is an allowance of higher frequencies, of the sweeter life, of living the dream, the old black and white existence is being shifted. This brings the stirring of the higher forces, higher energies into the black and white existence. It would be a wondrous stone for those who think too much, to bring the intellect into the center through the soul. It is a stone that would, with some stringency, clear out vestiges of the old ways, the cobwebs that would be at the door of the cave of remembering. This would be very good for clearing out what we might call stuck energy.

Capricorn will scale the highest of mountains in order to succeed. Number 15, the Devil's Play card, in the Voyager deck invites us to play with life. The Saturnian rulership of Capricorn can make things twothirds more serious and it is time to lighten up. When you spell EVIL backwards it spells LIVE.
