ASTROLOGY

NEW MOON

When the Sun and Moon rise together at the New Moon we are called to up spiral to the next level of the sign. Sagittarius emerges from the cave and cauldron of Scorpio searching for the meaning and wisdom to be gained from those alchemical tests and trials. Sagittarius is the third transpersonal fire sign and as such brings a quest for knowledge by exposure to new points of view. Traveling beyond the borders of everyday experience, we achieve a greater understanding of the world and our place in it.

This New Moon will broaden our horizons even more than the average New Moon. Our solar system, along with the entire Milky Way galaxy—and its stellar neighborhood of 40 other galaxies (called the Local Group), each with their billions of stars—are all moving toward an even larger gravitational source called the Great Attractor. Beyond this lies an even more colossal magnet called the Shapley Supercluster, a dense collection of approximately 20 major clusters of galaxies, all radiating huge amounts of radio waves and other forms of electromagnetic energy. (There are scientists and other people who would set up a scare about how the world will end, the galaxies will be destroyed and the Universe may eventually collapse. Everyone is up spiraling and the Universe is also. The changes that are occurring may actually further our growth and evolution rather than end it.)

Gravity bends light, and light encodes information, so this New Moon alignment with these super powerful transmission sources opens up a wormhole (a shortcut in time and space), enabling us to grasp things that are ordinarily beyond our field of awareness. Meditations during the peak of this New Moon and the next Full Moon, which aligns with the Galactic Center, can provide especially valuable insights and solutions.

Jupiter is the second largest source of radiation in our solar system (after the Sun). It sits at 24 degrees Pisces and is a part of a dynamic t-square, amplifying the

potential for revelations and leaps in consciousness that exceed what we have known before. Jupiter will join Uranus at 27 degrees and square both Mars and Phallas at 24 degrees Sagittarius while opposing Juno at 23 degrees Virgo. Juno and Phallas were two of the first asteroids discovered and named for feminine rather than masculine deities. This t-square highlights issues of inequality and injustice. Juno's legendary struggles with Jupiter symbolize the imperative to reconcile gender inequality. Phallas's birth from the head of Jupiter represents the requirement for foresight, creative intelligence and the perception of patterns. This powerful t-square heralds a time for domination and discrimination of any kind to cease. These are the times to let go of any and all beliefs and issues of your lineage that support unfairness.

Within hours after this New Moon Uranus turns direct after five months. Uranus in its direct course will encourage us to break out of mindsets of narrowness and stifling circumstances. Uranus went retrograde on July 5 at 0.36 degrees Aries. It will again reach that shadow point on March 22, 2011. All planets are now direct until Mercury turns retrograde on December 10 at 6 degrees Capricorn. Mars exactly cojoins the Galactic Center on December 3 which promotes quantum leaps of consciousness. Profound insights and important discoveries continue as Mars joins Mercury and Pluto on December 13 at 5 degrees Capricorn. It is now for us to find the questions that will bring us the answers we seek. Then we must be willing to listen.

The Sabian Symbol for this New Moon at 14 degrees Sagittarius suggests that reconnecting with spiritual knowledge that has been passed down through the ages can help us to meet our current challenges. We must seek the Ancient Mysteries rather than review the same old tired platitudes that have held us in limit for so long. "The Great Pyramid and the Sphinx stand as reminders of a glorious past; Achievement based on past greatness. Influence of the countless dead upon the living. Vast resources in selfhood. Antecedents." Find within yourself what is true for you and take the next great leap of faith on your way. Remember that your eyes only show you what you believe, not what you see.

FULL MOON

This Full Moon brings a total Lunar Eclipse on December 21. Four planets, two asteroids and the North Node of the Moon are involved in opposition to the Moon and South Node as this eclipse occurs. This is the third of five Full Moons that occur in the last degree of the sign, indicating that we are in a very important transitional time. The end degree of any sign as with the last sign Pisces requires that its energies be expressed with compassion and wisdom. Archetypes are the architecture of matter, the templates of energy, Matrices that shape and focus our perceptions. They are pathways for the evolution of consciousness.

This total eclipse expands our potential for transformation. As the old networks and connections of the past disappear we can open new pathways and options for evolution. When an eclipse occurs, the electromagnetic energy of the Sun and Moon streaming to the Earth is interrupted and this weakens the Earth's force fields as well as our own. These times provide an ease of shifting grids, dimensions and the way that our consciousness is configured. This eclipse is potentized by its proximity to the Galactic Center at 26 degrees 55 minutes Sagittarius. Any planet aspecting the Galactic Center concentrates the force of evolutionary codes streaming toward Earth all of the time, assisting us to remember who we are and bring fulfillment about our Soul Script.

Juno opposed Jupiter at the last New Moon, now opposes Uranus at 5 degrees 16 minutes Pisces/Virgo. This radically changes how we view relationships. Juno also tightly squares Mercury, the Sun and Moon in Sagittarius/Gemini, creating a mutable Grand Cross, a cosmic decree for far reaching change. If Phallas is included the essence of this Grand Cross, forms five oppositions and twelve squares. Three of the four major asteroids are involved in this extremely powerful configuration and Vesta, the fourth asteroid is also in Sagittarius. We stand at a point of decision about how we relate to each other in private partnerships, community involvement, national perspective and global outreach.

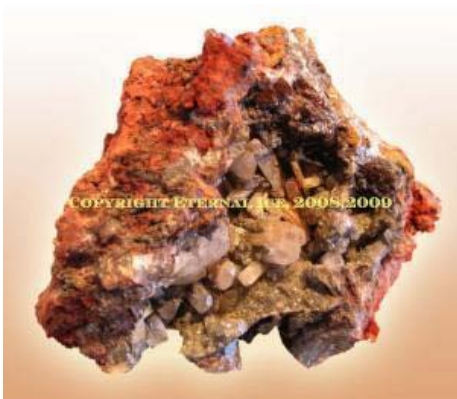
A Full Moon illuminates the shadow side of the sign. Sagittarius exhibits arrogance, overindulgence and a tendency to be fanatical. The desire for total freedom and absolute righteousness can go to extremes. Gemini brings forth from its shadow a tendency to rationalize, an amorous nature and duplicity. The Twins can separate head from heart, mental from physical and then attempt to present fiction as truth.

The Sun and Moon in the last degrees of these signs insists that we be clearly aligned with our true self and completely honest with others—no delusions, dogmatism or twisting truth to fit our own devises. As Jupiter approaches a conjunction with Uranus in Pisces we are shown the way out is through the remembrance that we are all One, “we have all been *there*” and that compassion for self and others is imperative. Just before the height of the eclipse is reached Venus reaches the point where she went retrograde at 13 degrees 14 minutes Scorpio on October 8. Here is another incentive to let go of all things in our life that keep us fearful, separate or conflicted.

The Sabian symbols remind us of the requirement to question our most fundamental beliefs and illusions. For the Sun at 30 degrees of Sagittarius: “The pope holding audience in a hall of the Vatican. Wealth of spiritual resources which can be tapped for the glorification of every relationship. Concrete form of ideals.” And for the Moon at 30 degrees of Gemini: “A parade of bathing beauties before large beach crowds. Use of individual vanity in raising racial standards. Examination of intellectual values for use in the soul life.” Questions arise as we change the direction of our perspective on how we relate to all things and people. Who am I? Why am I here? What is the purpose of life on this planet? Don’t just think about the answers. Feel into the energy and live the difference. The only way that people truly learn is from personal experience. Begin to live your experiences and experience your life every moment of every day.

CRYSTAL CORNER

Hello, everyone! Here we are at the end of another year, wondering what happened. How did New Year’s Day suddenly become December? For those desiring greater clarity, the following stones might assist.



HEMIMORPHITE is a stone for those who are reaching very rapidly into their becoming. It is the essence of the beginning of life and how it becomes cellularly from a concept, like a starburst, like a nova. It is as if it has come full circle, from God to God. It is to remind one of the completed circle. Those who are in fear of letting go of what they have been would find that what this stone brings them would terrify them. 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THE GARDEN FAIRY



Jerusalem Artichoke

Jerusalem artichoke (*Helianthus tuberosus* L.), a tuberous-rooted perennial sunflower, is familiar to many as a weed, but has some potential as a crop plant. Several North American Indian tribes used

Jerusalem artichoke as food prior to the arrival of European settlers. The explorer Champlain took Jerusalem artichokes from Canada to France in 1605 and originally called it Canadian artichoke. By the mid 1600's it was widely used as a human food and livestock feed there.

In France, the artichoke is called “topinambour,” although the word “Jerusalem” has several explanations. The artichoke became a staple food for North American pilgrims and was thought of as a new feed in a “new Jerusalem.” A second theory is that the word Jerusalem is a twisting of the Italian word for sunflower-girasol. One additional explanation involves a 17th century gardener named Petrus Hondins of Ter-Heusen, Holland who was known to distribute his artichoke apples throughout Europe. Ter-Heusen was modified to Jerusalem in the United States. In recent years the fresh tubers have been widely marketed in the U.S., but in quite limited quantities.

Similar to water chestnuts in taste, the traditional use of the tuber is as a gourmet vegetable. Jerusalem artichoke tubers resemble potatoes except the carbohydrates composing 75 to 80% of the tubers in the form of inulin (a low-calorie carbohydrate found in certain roots and tubers, barely affects blood sugar and improves digestive health as an unusual type of fiber and a prebiotic) rather than starch. Once the tubers are stored in the ground or refrigerated, the inulin is converted to fructose and the tubers develop a much sweeter taste. Dehydrated and ground tubers can be stored for long periods without protein and sugar deterioration. Tubers can be prepared in ways similar to potatoes. In addition, they can be eaten raw, or made into flour, or pickled. They are available commercially under several names, including sunchokes and lambchokes. Jerusalem artichokes have 650 mg potassium per 1 cup serving. They are also high in iron, and contain 10-12% of the US RDA of fiber, niacin, thiamine, phosphorus and copper.

About 50% of the 12 million tons of sugar consumed annually by Americans is grown and produced in the United States. Fructose is more soluble in water than sucrose, so fructose provides a more desirable syrup. In addition, it is 1.5 times sweeter than sucrose and can be consumed safely by diabetics. The majority of domestically produced fructose is obtained from corn. Although the Jerusalem artichoke is a viable fructose source, the U.S. sugar industry has been hesitant in utilizing it because farmers have been concerned with its potential as a weed problem, and because it requires extra planting and harvesting equipment along with storage difficulties.

In France, the artichoke has been used for wine and beer production for many years. Ethanol and butanol, two fuel grade alcohols, can be produced from Jerusalem artichokes. The cost of producing ethanol currently is not competitive with gasoline prices, and therefore the success of ethanol plants has been limited.

Jerusalem artichokes are easy to cultivate, which tempts gardeners to simply leave them completely alone to grow. However, the quality of the edible tubers degrades unless the plants are dug up and replanted in fertile soil. This can be a chore, as even a small piece of tuber will grow if left in the ground, making the hardy plant a potential weed.

The tubers have a consistency much like potatoes, and in their raw form have a similar texture to potatoes, but a sweeter, nuttier flavor; raw and sliced thinly, they are fit for a salad. The carbohydrates give the tubers a tendency to become soft and mushy if boiled, but they retain their texture better when steamed. The inulin is not well digested by some people, leading in some cases to flatulence and gastric pain.

Jerusalem artichokes also can be used in an animal feed, while they must be washed for most animals, pigs can harvest them through their own volition. The stalks and leaves can be harvested and used for silage, though cutting the tops greatly reduces the harvest of the roots. Currently, the only stable market is a limited one for the tubers as a gourmet vegetable.

Lemon Chicken with Jerusalem Artichokes

- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- 2 fresh lemons
- 2 Tablespoons olive oil, divided use
- 4 chicken thighs
- Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper
- 1 cup chicken broth
- 1/4 teaspoon ground saffron
- 1/2 pound Jerusalem artichokes (sunchokes), peeled
- 10 garlic cloves, peeled and halved
- 1/4 cup heavy cream
- 1 Tablespoon fresh thyme leaves

- 1/4 cup pine nuts, toasted

Finely grate, 1 tsp. of zest from the lemon and set aside. Squeeze juice from both lemons and save back.

Place a large, deep, heavy skillet over medium-high heat. When hot, add 1 Tbsp. of olive oil. Sprinkle chicken thighs on both sides with salt and pepper. Place chicken in hot pan and quickly brown them, turning only once. Remove to a plate and keep warm.

Add lemon juice, lemon zest remaining Tbsp. of olive oil, chicken broth, and saffron to the skillet. Bring to a boil, stirring to loosen any browned bits. Add Jerusalem artichoke and garlic cloves. Return chicken to the skillet, along with any accumulated juices.

Reduce heat and simmer about 45 minutes until chicken and sunchokes are tender. Stir in cream and thyme leaves. Taste and adjust seasoning, if needed. Return to a simmer and cook an additional 10 minutes.

Serve over cooked rice and sprinkle with pine nuts to garnish. Serves 4

LEGACY ON THE LAND

I want to share a book by a most interesting and exciting woman. Audrey Peterman is a woman of spunk and courage who has set out to make sure that people of color in America don't miss the wonders of our national parks. If you are a white American it might have never occurred to you that blacks, Native Indians and American born Orientals do not go to the National parks because many of them feel as though the parks do not belong to them.

Audrey and her husband Frank began to visit the parks and noticed that they were often the only people of color around. **Legacy on the Land** tells their story in an inviting and personal way. 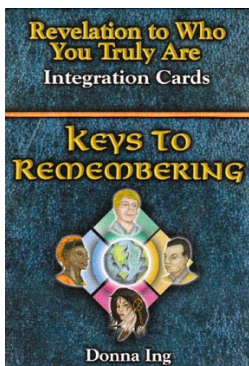
