### **FULL MOON**

The Full Moon in Cancer on January 10-11 starts the year off with a focus on healing with more parental issues. This is the first SuperMoon of 2009, it lights up the darkness to show us where we are and what direction we will take next. ### **NEW MOON**

This solar eclipse in Aquarius funnels the energies of Sun, Moon and Earth into a precise alignment. In the brief time that the Moon blocks the light of the Sun, the energetic grids that are the foundations of creation

are opened, restructured and then uploaded into the collective consciousness. Old programs are erased. The archetypes of the old ways are replaced and the veil between the earth and higher dimensions are moved aside a bit more—revelation. Sun, Moon, Jupiter, North Node, Chiron and Neptune are all in Aguarius for this New Moon indicating even more the significance of new beginnings and markings dramatic endings to the ways things have been done (forever). 
