ASTROLOGY

NEW MOON

The New Moon falls on June 14-15 and is in the sign of Gemini is associated with transformation—the butterfly coming out of it's cocoon—the mysteries of nature revealing themselves. Gemini is the first air sign and as such it stimulates the mental realms. Gemini's love to know something about everything,

but they often get bored if they have to spend too much time on any one thing. Gemini's are curious, open to new ideas and new sources of information.

Squares always bring tension and some frustration because they motivate us to move out of the rut and into unknown territory. Adults, often have much more problems with change than children because they feel they should already know how to do things. Children rush to each new learning experience with relish. Adults often move forward slowly with fear and/or judgments about their own ability to look intelligent when confronted with unknown circumstances. This is a testing time for everyone. June 25th will bring the third and last opposition between Saturn in Leo and Neptune in Aquarius.

Those born between 1947-1954, when Pluto was in the middle degrees of Leo, have gotten the biggest wake up call. However, we are all being pushed to own our creative gifts and unique abilities at this time. This opposition has been the column of light in the illusion, leading us to the clarity that will close the gap between our desires and the current limited beliefs of this time. "The Secret" has become one of the biggest new ideas to burst onto the horizon in quite some time and it appeared as Saturn and Neptune were moving into opposition. "The Secret" is leading many people out of the darkness of limitation and into the new light of possibilities that had been dismissed as "just imagination" before. Those who swear that the Law of Attraction doesn't work have not yet realized that they too are proving that it works unconditionally. What ever you say, you are right. We are learning that restrictions can build character, but we are never required to stay in adversity after we get the lesson. FULL MOON

Full Moons are always a time to measure our progress and make choices whether to continue along the path we are pursuing or change direction.

The Sun is in Cancer, the first water sign, directs attention to the emotion body and feelings, which are the higher octave of emotions. The Moon in Capricorn asks us if we are fulfilling our soul's purpose.

In Western society we have been taught to overlook or stuff our feelings. They are totally verboten in most areas of the life. Especially for men, showing any emotion but anger is considered unacceptable. "Big boys or girls don't cry" or "you are just overly sensitive". The judgment against feelings as a weakness, womanish or a nuisance, causes loss of the valuable guidance that feelings give us in daily affairs.

Deep feelings are kept in the closet and we are quickly learning in these times that you cannot control the emotional nature with your mind. A group of eminent doctors on the east coast got together and decided that since emotions could not be proven, they do not exist. How much fear of the unknown and uncontrollable does that show?

The Sun enters the sign of Cancer just before midnight ET on June 21. This marks the beginning of summer, the longest day of the year and a time of plenty related to crops, outdoor activities and the general freedom that warm weather brings.

For this Full Moon, Mercury which just went retrograde on June 25th, has moved to conjunct the Sun and Chiron (the wounded healer) co-joins Neptune. These aspects empower us to see new things that have been right in front of us, but out of sight because we had not yet moved to the vibrational frequency where they existed.

The lesson of Chiron in Aquarius is to get grounded and the conjunction with Saturn provides the necessary ballast to bring spirit into matter, rather believing that the only way to be spiritual is to leave the Earth plane. This is not the old time practice of reducing god to our level, but expanding ourselves enough to live spirit every moment of every day, here and now.

The nature of this Full Moon is to bring a new level of balance. We have been taught that we are nothing. We are now being called to remember, thorough unconditional love, that we are everything. THE POWER WITHIN

What could be more freeing than developing the personal power that resides within you? How wonderful to stand for what you believe and remain true to yourself! There are several stones that would facilitate aligning and grounding that empowerment.

Carnelian, an orange agate, is probably the most common stone used for power because it assists in setting fear aside. Its energy is more of a positive polarity as it is slightly more masculine than feminine. It would be used at the navel chakra, the second. If you always wanted to have a jewel in your navel, now's the chance!! Carnelian allows more of a focus on power and clearer understanding of what power really is, for the misconceptions of power have been much intertwined with the misconceptions of separation here. Therefore, this would assist one in coming to their power, feeling the power or feeling the misalignments where the connections are not made. It assists them to reconnect their power.

Another agate, Leopardskin agate, is used for aligning power. A dynamic placement would be to put a piece between the navel and the pelvic bone, in the middle of the body, and a piece on each point of the pelvis. For further enhancement, use clear Quartz and black Obsidian with it. The Quartz will amplify the energy and the Obsidian grounds the energy but also strips away illusions. That would be a nice bonus!

The peach-colored Garnet is an excellent stone for one doing the exercise of calling the light and calling all of their power back to themselves. Hold the stone or have it sitting close by as you familiarize yourself with your power. It helps to hold the frequency of reclamation and owning of one's own power.

Orange Selenite is a mineral that would be great to sit with at navel level for reconnecting with power, calling power home, meshing all of the energies that have been given for lifetimes, bringing emotion to center so there is a sense of peace and joy in the emotional nature rather than conflict and fear. I love the energy of these spheres!
