We are back from Maui and what an adventure it was. My first airplane ride was easy and uneventful. The jet lag afterward was anything but uneventful—three days of every kind of physical discomfort. I guess there was more stress than I realized.

There were so many blessings on the trip that I lost count. At every turn we were receiving little gifts from spirit. We received an upgrade on our condo to a much nicer resort and from an ocean-view to an ocean-front. Our balcony (we were on the fifth floor) looked out over a quarter mile of beautiful beach just below us. The ocean was turquoise, jade, cobalt and all of the beautiful colors that water can be as the sun moves and plays light on the water. The sun sets were so interesting. At approximately 6:30 p.m. each evening the sun dropped into the sea and was GONE! By 6:50p.m it was dark. Here in Wyoming we are still experiencing twilight until 8 p.m. That was very different.

We came back down the mountain and went to a wonderful lavender farm. There were over 200 different types of lavender growing there. They had been gathered from all over the world.

We had such a wonderful time the first weekend with Lazaris that we were looking forward to the second weekend, “A Gathering of Fairy and Human Magicians—A Feast of Magic”. The second weekend was called an intensive and it was intense. There was so much resistance to the changes that were being worked on us. People couldn’t stay awake, they missed the meditations because their minds would wander, and we hurt all over. Isn’t resistance fun? Wednesday we had a wonderful breakfast at a French bakery, went shopping for things we cannot find in Wyoming and that night we had an exceptional Thai dinner and went to see the stage play "Guys and Dolls". I had seen it when I was about nine years old and loved the music, but the story line was over the head of a child. I enjoyed seeing it again as an adult.

Thursday morning we got early and headed back to Wyoming, which was a two day drive. Even though we felt pretty good when we got home it took several days to adjust back to Wyoming time and St. Germain told us we would never be the same again. Maui is such a "no time/no-space" place and that feeling is still with us.

We experienced so much beauty and wonder on the whole trip. There were a few bumps, but most of it was one of the most amazing times of my life.

We made it home just in time to see the last of fall. In the high country the leaves had already fallen, but in Lander fall was actually just beginning. It is late this year. Usually our fall is finished before the end of September. Just one more gift, as I love the fall colors so much.

ASTROLOGY

FULL MOON

The Full Moon in November occurs on the 11-12, depending on where you are.

This is a Super Moon, which means that the Moon is at perigee (its closest approach to the Earth) and syzygy (either a New Moon or a Full Moon). SuperMoons function like laser beams, directing a constant stream of electromagnetic particles into more coherent channels of energy. SuperMoons can cause increased tides, weather and emotional reactions because of increased gravitational pulls. This Full Moon continues the impact of choices made at the last New Moon.

Since we are moving closer to the end of the Mayan calendar here is a bit of its history. According Mayan cosmology, the Thirteen Heavens, divided into seven days and six nights, representing the foundational stages of creation. From November 18, 2007 to November 12, 2008 we have been experiencing the 5th Night, a period fraught with economic upheaval as we witness the increasing breakdown of materialistic values and hierarchical structures. On the day of this Full Moon, we begin the 6th Day, which brings the dawning of a new direction and a new era.

(The Master St. Germain speaks of the foundational collapse of the old order and the necessity to move forward in ways that have no connection to how the past has functioned.)

Mayan scholar, Carl Johan Calleman, suggests that these times call for a shift from chaos to a more enlightened world. During this 6th Day large numbers of people will move toward an enlightened, global consciousness.

Lazaris, channeled by Jack Purcel, suggests that this is the time for us to dream the dreamers awake. Those who have been asleep throughout this game of separation must now wake up and participate in the evolution that is occurring on the planet.

This Full Moon makes a close alignment with Sedna at 21 degrees Taurus. Sedna in Taurus symbolizes a mass initiation into cosmic consciousness. Sedna orbit goes far beyond Pluto and it functions as a gateway to higher dimensional realities. Sedna is a plutoid first sighted in 2003 by the same group of astronomers that discovered Eris. The Sabian symbols underscore the import of these days and times. The Taurus Moon at 22 degrees: "White dove flying over troubled waters; the spiritual inspiration that comes to the individual in the overcoming of crisis." For the Sun at 22 degrees Scorpio: "Hunters shooting wild ducks; the socially accepted release of an individuals' or a group's aggressive instincts." The focus is on our divine core rather than on the trappings of the illusions that we are things and stuff.

NEW MOON

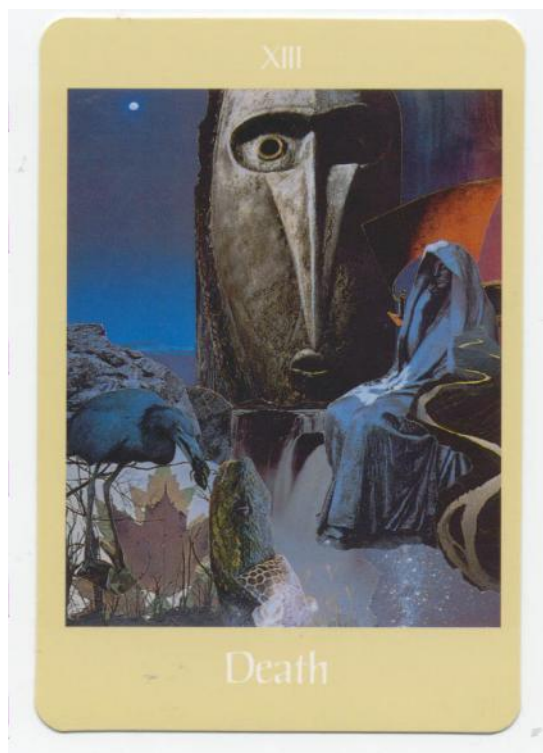

Orange is not usually associated with the crown chakra but it does bring a balance of recognizing who you are, the owning of power from a higher level of understanding.

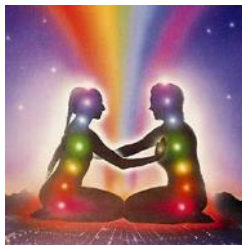
