

OCTOBER NEWSLETTER

I just returned from a trip to Lake Tahoe for a "busman's holiday to see Lazaris. What an amazing place Tahoe is. We stayed at the Granlibakken hotel/resort. The fall colors were beginning there. By the time we got back to Lander a lot of the color was gone. However, around our house the trees and bushes are beautiful and still intense.

October brings my time of travel to the east for our fall intensive and to spend time at the beautiful Crystal Organic Farm. Fortunately, the only thing that burned down was an old barn that didn't seem to be in use. The wind drove the fire

I don't know how many of you are experiencing an increase of magik (you think of something you desire and it happens), but we surely are. These changing times can be trying, but they are *never* boring.

ASTROLOGY

On the 26th of September we experienced a SuperMoon ('su-per'mun) [etymology: coined by author Richard Nolle, in Dell Horoscope, September 1979]

A lunar perigee-syzygy, a New or Full Moon (syzygy) occurring when the Moon is at or near (within 90 % of) its closest approach to Earth (perigee)

Technology aside the SuperMoon is an extremely powerful lunar influence. Every new and Full Moon is special in its own right, but the SuperMoons have an extra punch in how they stir up earth activity and how they cause us to be hyper-sensitive to our own emotional natures.

The Full Moon is a dynamic that is very noticeable in the sky; where as the New Moon is not so visible. The experiential influence is much more inward with the New Moon, where as, the Full Moon effects our outward/physical affairs more. Police and medical practitioners prefer not to be on shift when the Moon is full—hence the term lunacy.

So what does the SuperMoon do and what is it good for?

It is a strong signal of geological disturbances—tidal surges in Earth's atmosphere, oceans and outer skin that correspond to severe storms, exceptionally high tides and moderate to severe seismic activity, including volcanic eruptions, as well as magnitude 5+ and higher earthquakes. SuperMoons, eclipses and lunar declinations are all aspects that create extreme geological upsets.

A Lunar declination is determined by the movement of the Moon in its monthly cycle and how far it swings above (north) and below (south) the Earth. In years when the declinations or swings are extreme the incidence of earth activity—quakes, storms, hurricanes--is higher.

We will have a Super Moon on October 26th and on November 24th of this year, so this fall certainly could bring some interesting action from Mother Earth.

NEW MOON

The New Moon in October falls on the 10th-11th depending on where in the world you are.

Libra (We) is about relationships so as we look at this New Moon we will consider the mirrors that relationships give us. We learn much more about ourselves when we are involved with others.

Neptune is trine this New Moon and brings us insights and intuition around our relationships and how we will expand them or shift to another point of view.

On the 13th of October, Venus will make it's third conjunction with Saturn. The first two occurred in Leo and involved clarifying what our heart's desire is so that we might bring it about. This conjunction takes place in Virgo and focuses our attention on improving our relationships, our health and our finances.

This New Moon provides an excellent opportunity to bring into the open issues that might be causing difficulty in current relationships and, perhaps setting goals for new directions. Communications are important now.

Squares always represent turning points in our lives and Jupiter and Uranus just completed their third square this year. Jupiter in Sagittarius broadens the scope of our vision and Uranus in Pisces sharpens our sixth sense. In February of 1997 Jupiter and Uranus were conjunct in Aquarius. Things that were set in motion then are up for review. What would you change? How will you move forward into new ideas now? Mercury is preparing to go retrograde on October 11, at 9 degrees Scorpio and will turn direct on November 1. It will complete the retrograde on November 17 when it again returns to 9 degrees Scorpio. Mercury in Scorpio delves into our unconscious and brings up hidden motivations. This can show us the connection between intimacy and honesty. This retrograde calls us to let go of old resentments and misunderstandings. If we are to move forward now we must forgive the past. Holding grudges holds us in place—we get stuck.

This New Moon gives us an opportunity to look at the breakdown between the individual and the society. We are all becoming more independent as we begin to remember who we are, but Mastery has nothing to do with dominating others. We are Divine, not corrupt. The laws of man are often subject to the mood of the judge, whether he is in a courtroom or on the street. Willfulness prevents us from creating the peaceful society that we desire. Focus directed in love brings about a new outlook.

FULL MOON

This is the second SuperMoon this year.

Full Moons bring light to the dark, hidden places of our lives. This Full Moon is in the Taurus/Scorpio axis. Scorpio is all about our secrets, our hidden agendas and our taboos.

The sacred science of alchemy describes the process of transmuting one's own darkness. Ancient Egypt was known as Al-Kemi, "the Black Land," famed for its fertile soil (the fertile crescent) and Occult (hidden) knowledge. Black represents base matter, associated with lead or Saturn and on the metaphysical level with the id or unconscious. Gold is the refinement of this baser consciousness into an enlightened state, the achievement of purity and clarity. The Bible says "When the eye is single, we see God". This refinement moves us from our blindness (the land of Nod-asleep state) to the open inner eye, that helps us to see ourselves and others in a much more compassionate and caring way.

The Goddess Mother is identified with Taurus, because she brings the fulfillment (fertility) of all our desires. In this most alchemical time we are being awakened from the eons of illusion we have drifted into and the clarion call of our deepest, truest nature is bringing us to at-one-ment with God/Goddess/All that is.

Two days after the Full Moon Pluto, ruler of Scorpio makes its third and last alignment with the exact Galactic Center. This offers excellent support for releasing old stagnant, out-moded ideas that no longer serve us.

The Black Hole that lies at the center of our Milky Way is four million times larger than our Sun and it provides us with an evolutionary system that will sustain us in the changes that we all now must make. These changes have been recorded by the Mayan End Times, the Hopi Fifth World, the Turning of the Ages, Timewave Zero, the Ascension and the Great Awakening, to mention a few. These prophecies signal a dimensional shift that humanity is making that cannot be avoided. Pluto's movement into Capricorn, which represents the old order, in January heralds the return to the light from the shadow world that we have lived in for eons. This is the Hermit's decent into the cave to emerge renewed. CHAIRMAN MAO'S LIGHTER

Ever had a brilliant gift idea that turned out to be the most embarrassing and humiliating thing you could have brought to the party? At a conference on consciousness we were told to bring a small, wrapped present to exchange as a means of getting to know each other. The gift was supposed to be related to something significant in our lives. After wracking my brains for awhile, and looking around the house, I found the perfect thing: a lighter I had brought back from China. It was a souvenir from the first time I ever hosted a group tour, which has become a yearly event since then.

Ah, but this was no ordinary lighter. It was a solid lighter with some heft to it, covered in bright red enamel. On one side, the imposing face of Chairman Mao stares out at you, totally out of context on this goofy trinket. Sort of like Abraham Lincoln on a box of Wheaties. But the kicker is that when you open the top, it plays a silly (and quite frankly annoying) Chinese marching song, which squeals on and on -- lit or not -- until you close it. Or until the battery runs out, should you leave it open for a few days as a sort of Chinese torture for the unlucky people you live with. In short, it's pretty funny. And it kind of reduces Mao to the status of a cartoon, which I like.

I've given a few of these away to friends, and everybody gets a kick out of them. My brother likes to walk down the grocery store aisle with his lighter held aloft, music blaring and people staring. I think he does it to embarrass his daughter. But I digress...

So I felt quite proud of myself for bringing this funny, clever gift that I knew everyone at the conference would find amusing. That first night, all 120 of us were sorted into small circles of eight, and instructed to put our presents in the middle. One by one we took turns choosing a gift that someone else had brought, and then we took turns unwrapping them. When someone opened the gift you brought, you explained what it meant to you, and so we'd get to know a bit about each other.

But what happened in our little circle was a kind of cosmic joke.

Imagine: out of all the 120 people at this event, the one person who ended up with my little wrapped package containing this incredibly funny, brilliantly clever, totally unique Chairman Mao lighter, just happened to be the childhood/ lifelong friend, as well as the official biographer of.......the Dalai Lama.

I'm not kidding.

He was seated just to my left. As soon as I saw him pick up the little package, I felt myself shrink about five sizes. What I really wanted was to disappear altogether. If humiliation was a color, I would have been a bright orange 4th of July smoke bomb, just fizzing away into nothing. I didn't know there would be a Tibetan at this conference. I didn't know there would be a man who, as I later found out, actually fought Chinese soldiers and was forced to flee into exile as they took over and brutalized his country.

All the time we were going around the circle opening presents, I was sitting there, completely freaked out at the fact that I'd brought the most insulting gift I possibly could have, and it was going to be unbearably awkward when this gentle, elderly, dignified, much-loved man opened it. It was unbelievably embarrassing. Life-shattering buckets of shame. For once in my life, I'd been just a little too clever, and my sick sense of humor had come back to haunt me. How could I possibly explain this to him? What could I say, especially when all the other gifts were so thoughtful and beautiful? What would he say? What would he do?

When it got to be my turn, I suggested we switch presents.

"Why?" he asked.

"Because I don't think you'll like it. I want you to have something you'll like."

"No," he said. "I chose this one."

Slowly and calmly, he unwrapped the lighter. He turned it over, and for a minute just looked at the picture of Mao. I can't remember if he opened the top and played the little song.

After what seemed like forever, during which time I would have gladly traded my whole life to be somewhere else, he spoke.

"Oh," he said firmly. "This is karma."

He looked at me with steady, sincere eyes and said, "This will help me remember to practice compassion."

POSTSCRIPT #1

The next morning, I was relating this episode to one of the conference organizers, and she insisted I tell the entire gathering about it. So I got up in front of the group and told this story. When I mentioned who got the lighter, everybody gasped. And then when I told them what Kuno (his nickname) had said, Kuno stood up, smiled and bowed low, and everybody laughed. And right then we all got it that he was really okay about it.

During the week of this conference, every time I saw Kuno he would shake my hand and thank me for the lighter. So by the end of the week, we had kind of become buddies. On the last morning, he sat next to me at lunch. We talked about Dharmsala, where the Tibetan refugees live with the Dalai Lama, and about life in India. I told him I'd always wanted to go there, and about hosting my group tours. Kuno picked up on this immediately. He invited me to Dharmsala, and said he had friends who would handle all the travel arrangements for us. We could even do some kind of a concert with myself and some Tibetan musicians. He was really into the whole idea, and I got all excited at the prospect too.

It's amazing how things work out sometimes.

POSTSCRIPT #2

(A letter from a friend at the conference, reporting how Kuno described this experience.)

"Dear Greg,

I love that you tell the story about your lighter, but you must tell more of the story. The way you ended it made it sound like he was being polite--but it was MUCH more than that. It was huge, and wonderful.

You should have heard Kuno's talk at the International House after the Conference. He began to talk about his history and connection with the Dalai Lama, and he briefly mentioned his important role as a general in the war. He spoke about how the Chinese killed his parents, family members, and so many of his friends. He talked about his anger at the Chinese--so much anger. He talked about how the Dalai Lama told him many times, he needed to make peace with the Chinese, to not hate them, to have love in his heart, compassion, forgiveness. He saw no way to do this, it was impossible, he hated them all to such an extent that he wouldn't even eat Chinese food. The Dalai Lama would laugh at this and tell him that Chinese food is very good and his anger is making him miss out on some very good things.

Well, before the conference Kuno was visiting a site

of one of the bloody battles between China and Tibet where he lost many friends. He was at the memorial, trying to make peace, but only feeling anger, pain and sadness. He began to cry. A couple was there, crying also. They and Kuno started talking about their issues, and began bonding. After a while they decided to go to a place for some food and to talk more. During the meal each asked where the other was from, and it turned out that the couple was Chinese! He had thought they were on his side, not theirs. Karma again. They continued their meal together with new understanding. This experience totally changed his perspective.

He wanted to continue healing so he then started trying to get to know Chinese people. He tried Chinese food and liked it. When the conference organizer invited Kuno to be with us, he also wanted to set up some lectures for Kuno in the area and offered to let him stay at his house. Kuno told him that he would like to do the lectures, but he wanted to stay with a Chinese family, if possible. The organizer said that would be very easy to organize since his foreign-exchange student host family lived nearby, and they just happen to be Chinese! (Coincidence? I think not.) Kuno stayed with the Chinese family before and after the conference and had a wonderful time in their home.

After a couple of days with them, he came to our conference and received your lighter. At this point in his lecture, he held up your lighter, lit it, and played the little song. He told the story of getting the lighter at the conference, of all the groups he could have been with, of all the wrapped gifts he could have picked, he picked you and yours.

It was a gift, supporting his new path to healing. At the time you picked the gift, you didn't know about his new found attempts at healing this pain in his heart, but you helped the process and supported his new path.

I bet the Dalai Lama had a big belly laugh when Kuno told the full story to him.

It's a full circle thing.


If I were you, I'd be honored to be part of that healing circle.

Amplifier (large and small)

How to Use the Amplifier:
